Eligibility: Medina County high school graduating seniors who are continuing their art education in college (as a major or minor) following graduation.

Rules for Submissions: Each student must submit a collection of five (5) pieces of art. 2D art must be in a portfolio labeled with the student's name and school. Portfolios must include completed application, a copy of college acceptance letter, and a list of works. Each piece must be individually labeled. 2D pieces should be no larger than 48" in any direction. **No frames. Art must either be matted and backed securely with strong Velcro on the back or stretched canvas with picture wire for hanging.** Heavier pieces must have enough support that they will not fall when hung. 3D artwork no larger than 22"x22"x28" may be included in the total of five pieces. Work may be from class projects. Be sure to follow all the guidelines listed above so you aren't disqualified. Winners will be notified by email. Decisions of the judges are final. Prizes will be awarded by the Medina County Art League.
