# In a year as extraordinary as 2020, how do we talk about library achievements and progress?

Some days we felt challenged to deliver the most basic service. Other days we were reinventing services and routines from the ground up. Either way, we continued to serve the community every day, in every way we could, within the rapidly changing situation.

We used our mission as a guide to make difficult decisions. Enriching life in our communities with outstanding and innovative library services for all took on new meaning during the pandemic and continues to evolve today.

When our branches had to close, staff quickly implemented virtual services and programs. We expanded our digital collection so the community could access books, movies, magazines, and music from the safety of their homes. We added hotspots to borrow and boosted the exterior WiFi to help with access. While some new services, such as Chat with a Librarian and Curbside Service came into being, several long-standing services like Anytime Lockers and Outreach deliveries found new popularity.

Even with all of 2020's challenges and changes, 2,723 new library cards were issued, with many being digital cards. Welcome to these new patrons! We hope you find your way into the library buildings and we're pleased to continue providing you with virtual services. To our long-standing library users, we enjoy seeing your masked faces in our buildings and thank you for your patience.

The staff and I are grateful for the dedication of the Board of Trustees, the Friends of the Library, library volunteers, and community partners who help make MCDL an integral part of Medina County. I look forward to working together in 2021 and beyond to find new ways to meet library needs for every resident. I hope to see you soon in one of our branches or virtual events.

## **Curbside Service**

When MCDL reopened in June, Curbside was ready to roll. Patrons arrange for pick up, call upon arrival, and staff place items in a trunk or backseat. More than 1,800 transactions took place in just over six months.

While still closed, MCDL began offering live Chat with a Librarian for reference questions. This service continues for patron convenience at mcdl.info/Chat.


## **Door Drop Delivery**

When the Bookmobile stopped due to social distancing, staff changed all home and senior care facility visits to no-contact door drop delivery; and added 33 new patrons between July and December. Staff provide weekly door drop delivery to about 75 patrons.


